- This flute competition is open to all Long Island flutists in grades 10-12 who have not previously won 1st place in the LIFC Competition.
- Any NYSSMA level VI solo is acceptable for audition. The number of movements must satisfy the NYSSMA requirements for an All-State audition. **Works with piano parts must be accompanied.**
- Previous contestants must enter on a different solo each year.
- Previous winners who have not fulfilled their pledge promise to the LIFC Winner's Recital may not apply.
- To register: (1) **Complete** the application below; (2) **Enclose a \$25.00 application fee** (make checks payable to LIFC, Inc.); (3) **Enclose a brief biography** that **must include the following statement**: "If I am a finalist, I agree to perform in a flute ensemble at the Winner's Recital on March 9, 2008. If I am an award winner, I agree to perform my solo at the Winner's Recital on March 9, 2008.
